The Advanced Training is a small class open ONLY to Certified Trager Practitioners who are current members in good standing of The Trager Institute. The training consists of two parts — a Reflex Response Lab followed by the Trager Learning Clinic. In the R/R Lab, Dr. Trager teaches his work with paralysis, a special aspect of Psychophysical Integration which he employed most successfully in his own clinic in Mexico. In the TLC, Dr. Trager supervises the Advanced student's work with people who have such learning difficulties as MS, MD, polio, stroke, post-accident, arthritis, chronic pain, LBS, ALS, Parkinsons, asthma-emphysema, CP and the like. Advanced students in the TLC will have several opportunities to work and to observe as well as to discuss the experience with Dr. Trager. Parts of the Training will be video taped. Applicants need to have completed at least 2 Intermediate trainings with Dr. Trager to be considered.
